Text: 2 Timothy 2:15

Introduction:

The Bible speaks to people in two primary ways:

1) Universally – to everyone. This is the logos (word) which became flesh.

2) Personally – rhema (word)

Logos – John 1:1 & 14 and Hebrews 1:1 – 2

Rhema – 2 Kings 5:14 & Isaiah 54:2

Only the Holy Spirit can make a logos word a rhema word.

Matthew 4:4

2) Faith to act and obey: Hebrews 11:7 and Matthew 14:22 – 33

3) Faith to receive God's promises: Matthew 1:23

5) Faith (key) to receiving guidance from God: John 16:13

6) Faith (rhema word) is the key to meditation: Joshua 1:8

7) Faith (rhema word) is key to victories in our personal walk: James 4:7
