Revelation 5:5, "And one of the elders said to me, "Weep no more; behold, the Lion of Judah, the Root of David, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals."

 - a) "Weep no more" time to REJOICE
 - b) "the Lion of the tribe of Judah" prophecy fulfilled Genesis 49:9 - 10
 - c) "the Root of David" the gospel of Matthew, Revelation 22:16; Romans 15:12
 - d) "has conquered" 1 Corinthians 15:55 57; Hebrews 2:14 - 18
 - e) "he can open the scroll" John 6:38; Psalm 91:11 - 13

The Lamb:

Revelation 5:6, "And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, with seven horns, with seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth."

2.1) This is part of true Revelation of Jesus Christ: "a Lamb standing" - REJOICE

He was slain but is risen!

- 2.2) This was the definite plan of God Acts 2:23-24
- 2.3) Jesus Christ the Lamb of God John 1:29 & 36
- 2.4) Jesus Christ is our Passover Lamb 1 Corinthians 5:7
