## Moses, Moses...Remove Your Sandals:

1.1) Exodus 3:1 - 6

*"Then he said, "Do not come near; take your sandals off your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."  
We can never stand before a Holy and Righteous God on the basis of anything that we have done!"*

1.2) Isaiah 64:6

*"We have all become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a polluted garment. We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away."*

1.3) Psalm 1:4- 5

*"The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; for the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish."*

## Redeemed...Put Sandals On:

2.1) Sandals need to be put on:

Ephesians 6:15; Romans 10:10 - 15; John 12:21

*"So these came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and asked him, "Sir, we wish to see Jesus."*

2.2) Sandals are for walking:

Ephesians 4:1 - 6; Ephesians 5:1 & 2; 15 - 18

Matthew 10:38 & 39

*"And whoever does not take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."*

2.3) Sandals are for standing:

A) Standing on the Rock:

Psalm 40:1 - 3; Exodus 17:6; 1 Corinthians 10:4

B) Standing on the promises: 2 Peter 1:4 - 7

C) Standing on the blood of Jesus: 1 John 1:5 - 10
