- ~ The destination in our spiritual journey is: Romans 8:29, "For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers."
- ~ Compare with 2 Corinthians 3:18, "And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.'

1. Not Trained for This:

~ Exodus 1:8 – 11 Israelites were made slaves in Egypt to prevent them from becoming a military fifth column within Egypt.

2. Never Faced This Before:

~ Joshua 6:1, "Now Jericho was shut up inside and outside because of the people of Israel. None went out, and none came in."

Jericho (Tell es-Sultan) is an 8 acre mound about a mile northwest of the modern oasis of Jericho known as er-Riha. John Garstang in the 1930's found evidence that Jericho was a double-walled city and that the walls had fallen outward.

3. No Catapults or Ramps or Siege:

- ~ Siege examples: Battle of Verdun, February 21, 1916 to December 18, 1916 Siege of Malta, June 1940 to November 1942
- ~ What is the God given strategy to take Jericho? Joshua 6:1 - 11

4. New Strategy for Believers on the Journey:

~ A New Creation: 2 Corinthians 5:17, "Therefore, if any-

one is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."

(The name of our fellowship)

- ~ A Divine Helper: John 14:15 17, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. (16) And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, (17) even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him not knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you."
- ~ A New Mind: 1 Corinthians 2:14 16, "The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned. (15) The spiritual person judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one. (16) "For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" But we have the mind of Christ."
