## Title: God's Promise to Abraham Their Fulfillment

Series: Christmas 2025 ... 2 Text: Genesis 3:1 - 24

**Purpose:** I want to INFORM my congregation of some of the promises made to Abraham and their fulfillment.

#### Introduction:

Last week, as we enter the Advent season, we considered Genesis 3 – Humanity's Death and God's Promise:

- ~ 1. Penalty to the Serpent;
- ~ 2. Promise to Eve of Having Offspring (Seed);
- ~ 3. Promise of a Specific Offspring (Seed)
  - ~ Christ Jesus is a New Testament figure, why are we in the Old Testament?
  - ~ Luke 24:13 49 (Read)
  - ~ Luke 24:27, "And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself."
  - ~ Luke 24:45, "Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures,"
  - ~ Remember in the New Testament when the Holy Spirit speaks of the Scriptures, as referenced here, He is referring to what we call the Old Testament.

## 1. Abraham Receives Promises From God:

~ Genesis 12:1 – 3, "Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. (2) And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. (3) I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

NOTICE: ~ 1. A land I will show you, ~ 2. I will make you a great nation, ~ 3. make your a great name, ~ 4. you will be a blessing, ~ 5. I will curse those who dishonor you, ~ 6. all the families of the earth will be blessed in you

~ Genesis 15:1 – 21 (Read)

NOTICE: ~ vs.1 I am you shield; your reward shall be very great. ~ vs. 4 your very own son shall be your heir. ~ vs. 5 large number of offspring ABRAM vs. 6, "And he believed the LORD, and he counted it to him as righteousness."

- ~ Galatians 3:5 8, "Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith—(6) just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"? (7) Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham."
- -- That is every believer in Christ Jesus! We are the spiritual seed.
- ~ Galatians 3:16, "Now the promises were made to Abraham and to his offspring. It does not say, "And to offsprings," referring to many, but referring to one, "And to your offspring," who is Christ."

That is Christ Jesus, God come in the flesh, who will yet establish His earthly kingdom.

### 2. Abraham Receives a Son From God:

- ~ Genesis 17:19, "God said, "No, but Sarah your wife shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac, I will establish my covenant with him as an everlasting covenant for his offspring after him."
- ~ Genesis 21:1 7 (Read)
- ~ Genesis 22:1 24 (Read)
- $\sim$  Genesis 24:1 4 and 62 67 (Read)
- ~ Isaiah 7:14, "Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel."
- ~ Isaiah 9:6-7, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (7) Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this."
- ~ NOTICE: that some of this prophecy is history and some is yet future!

#### Conclusion:

Jesus is coming back for His bride and then He shall rule for a thousand years!

Revelation 22:17, "The Spirit and the Bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price."
